

**Eligibility Instructions for Tsinghua University International  
Undergraduate Applicants (Nationality Status) 2027**

Applicants must be foreign nationals who do not hold Chinese nationality under *the Nationality Law of the People's Republic of China*. At the time of application, they must hold a valid foreign passport or other valid proof of foreign nationality.

- Applicants who were formerly Chinese citizens and subsequently acquired foreign nationality must no longer hold Chinese nationality. Applicants must hold valid foreign passport or foreign nationality certificates for at least 4 years (inclusive) and must have resided in the foreign country for at least two years within the most recent four-year period. The above mentioned four-year period ends on the April 30 of the year of enrollment. A “year-cycle” is defined as the period from May 1 to April 30 of the following year. Any cycle in which the applicant physically resided overseas for 9 months or longer will be counted as one year toward this requirement, verified by entry and exit stamps.
- Applicants whose parent or parents are Chinese citizens and have settled abroad, who were born abroad, acquired foreign nationality at birth, and have never held Chinese nationality, must meet the following conditions at the same time:
  1. Applicants' Chinese-citizen parent or parents have acquired

foreign permanent residence by the time the applicants were born.

2. Applicants must hold valid foreign passport or foreign nationality certificates for at least 4 years (inclusive), ending on April 30 of the enrollment year.
3. Within the most recent four-year period (ending on April 30 of the enrollment year), applicants must have resided in the foreign country for at least two years in total (Applicants who have lived abroad for 9 months or more within any year-cycle may have that period counted as one year of overseas residence, verified by entry and exit stamps).

Applicants should submit all materials proving the above-mentioned circumstances at once via the application system before the deadline in accordance with the requirements set out in *Submission Requirements for International Undergraduate Applicants Regarding Nationality Status Documentation 2027*.

If an applicant is found ineligible to apply, or if, before graduation or completion of studies, the applicant is deemed not to qualify as an international student as defined in the *Administrative Measures for the Enrollment and Cultivation of International Students by Schools* (Order No. 42 jointly issued by the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of

Foreign Affairs, and the Ministry of Public Security), the University will take action according to the stage at which the issue is discovered. If discovered at the application stage, the applicant's application eligibility will be revoked; if discovered before enrollment, the applicant's eligibility to enroll will be revoked; if discovered after enrollment, the applicant's admission qualification or student status will be revoked; and if discovered after graduation or completion of studies, any academic credential or degree certificate already issued will be revoked in accordance with the law.
