

List of Documents to be uploaded in the Online Application System

(for International applicants of Undergraduate Programs)

The documents (colored scanned copy of the original version) listed below should be uploaded in the Online Application System. Please prepare the original copies as well as the specified number of photocopies to the integrative test /official registration for further verification.

1. Nationality related materials: applicants must upload all the required materials according to [*Submission Requirements for Tsinghua University International Undergraduate Applicants Regarding Nationality Status Documentation 2027*](#).
2. The final degree certificate or pre-graduation certificate (in Chinese or English, must be an original copy). The high school diploma must be obtained through full-time, in-person education.
 - 1) Certificate of pre-graduation issued by the high school that will issue the diploma, the expected graduation time should be indicated (for applicants who will graduate from high school by August 2027);
 - 2) Graduation certificate of high school (for applicants who have already graduated from high school);
 - 3) Certificate of enrollment from the university (for applicants who are studying in a university).
3. Curriculum Vitae (in Chinese or English).
4. High school/University (if applicable) transcripts (in Chinese or English, must be original copy).
 - 1) Currently available high school transcripts (for applicants who will graduate from high school by August 2027);
 - 2) Complete set of high school transcripts (for applicants who have already graduated from high school);
 - 3) High school transcripts and the currently available university transcripts (for applicants who are studying in a university).
5. Test Report of HSK Level 5 or above, with scores above 60 in each of the following categories: Listening, Reading, and Writing (within the validity period, applicants for English-taught programs are not required to provide this).
6. Certificate of National/Regional Graduation Examination/Matriculation Examination (e.g. ATAR/ Abitur/ BAC/CSAT/ UEC/STPM/others) and/or the results of international standard tests (e.g. CSCA/SAT/ACT/A-Level/AP/IB/others).
7. Test Report of English language test (e.g. TOEFL/IELTS/others, within the validity period).
8. Two Recommendation Letters: the letter template will be sent directly to the recommender's email address by the online application system.
9. Personal statement (in Chinese or English).
10. Form for the Financial Sponsor (template is available in the online application system), Employment or Income Certificate of the Financial Sponsor.
11. Proof of HSK test waiver (native language is Chinese or learning in Chinese in high school, applicants for English-taught programs are not required to provide this).
12. Self-Introduction Video (in both Chinese and English, no more than 3 minutes & less than 20 MB. The format of the video can be: mov, mp4, avi, rmvb, flv).
13. Portfolio (for applicants who are applying for Arts Division (Design & Fine Arts) or Architecture Division), there is no limitation on the number or the form of the works; Form for confirming that student has independently completed the Architecture Portfolio (template is available in the online application system).
14. Other supporting materials such as awards, admission letter(s) from other universities, etc.
15. In addition to the documents mentioned above, Tsinghua University may require further information and materials.

Note:

1. All materials listed above must be original copy in Chinese or English. If the original copy is of 3rd party language (such as Korean), then a notarized translated copy (in Chinese or English) must be submitted with the original.
2. The diplomas issued by different types of high school in mainland China listed below are all acceptable:
 - 1) For those who are studying in the regular high school in mainland China, please provide the diploma issued by the local education administration department;
 - 2) For those who are studying in the high school established by foreign organization/enterprise (the school has to be authorized by the Ministry of Education of the PRC), the diploma will be acceptable after verification by Tsinghua university;
 - 3) For those who are studying in the international school or Sino-foreign cooperative education organization, please provide the diploma as well as the Permit of Sino-foreign Cooperative Education of the PRC.
3. Those who have passed the Comprehensive Assessment are required to provide the following hardcopy documents to Tsinghua University: 1. Nationality-related materials 2. Application form (generated by the Online Application System) with your signature, 3. High school transcript(s) (original copy or authorized photocopy) and other required materials. All hard copies of application materials once received will not be returned. Please do not send any original documents for which you can only obtain one copy (e.g. passport).
4. Applicants under 18 (by September 1, 2027) must provide a certificate identifying a legal guardian in China. The guardian of the students must currently live in Beijing. The guardian can be of any nationality and must have a source of income.
